# Ecotourism is an alternative tourism


- Ecotourism, includes learning about the natural environment or visiting natural areas in a way that respects the environment

- o protect natural resources , don't harm ecosystems.






#### • **Protection of the natural environment:** Destroying of natural areas is minimized.

Awareness is created by educating visitors about the importance and protection of the natural environment.


